





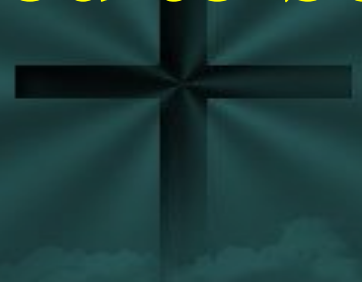
ROMANS 8:18-27 (NIV)

19 - The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of God to be revealed.




ROMANS 8:18-27 (NIV)

20 - For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope




ROMANS 8:18-27 (NIV)

22 - We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.





has?




ROMANS 8:18-27 (NIV)
